Standards myths

« *Standards aren't relevant to my business* »

« *Standards only apply to products* »

« *We don't need standards, we already have the best solution* »

« *I don't have a say in the content of standards* »

« *Standardization is expensive* »

What we do?

- Set up standards and other standardization deliverables at national level
- Implement European and International standards at national level
- Develop partnership with Universities and Research organizations
- Facilitate SME's involvement in European and International Standardization
- Manage the National Standardization Mirror Committees (NMC)
- Grant access to standardization

What we offer?

- “No Pay to Play” conditions to get involved in Technical Committees (TC)
- Searching and ordering standards *via* Internet
- Free of charge consultation of standards at ILNAS premises (eLibrary)



2 – Who writes the standard?


- Volunteer experts

- National Standards Bodies




Actors/participants to the process (all interested and concerned parties)



Experts, delegates and stakeholders at national level




Standardization Expert Groups






The Mechanism: 4 Major Milestones






ISO Development process (identical at CEN level)



- Letter of motivation
- CV
- Signed copy of ILNAS/OLN/P001

Conformity & file check

Board Meeting (Comité de direction Normalisation) :

- Analysis : professional know how + national interest
- Decision on registration

Registration to « Registre national des délégués en normalisation » :

- Notification of the decision by letter
- National registration to the Technical Committee
- Creation access account

Rights and Duties

Rights

- Access to committee documents (TC working documents)
- Active contribution to draft standards
- Vote on future standards (national interests)
- Participation to European and/or International meetings (fees charged to the delegate)
- Use of the Logo « Member of ILNAS Network »

Duties

- Respect of the ILNAS/OLN Policy and the rules laid down for the use of the logo ([ILNAS/OLN/A003](#))
- Non-communication of the content of committee documents to third parties
- Standardization activity within the Technical Committee involved
- Periodical report to OLN (Personal activity, Meetings, Comments, etc.)
