Policy on Education about standardization 2013-2020 Introduction

Goals

- To ensure the development of a unified technical standardization culture in Luxembourg
- > To achieve and guarantee a societal, national "anchorage" of this issue by 2020

Foundations

- ILNAS acts directly as the national body for promoting standards-related education
- > ILNAS is structuring standards-related education in conjunction with institutions and bodies involved in this area and in the respect of:
 - > the specifications of the 2009-2014 government program
 - > the various European Union recommendations
- ILNAS has chosen to base its activity on « the Masterplan on Education about Standardization » document guidelines, developed by the European standardization organizations CEN, CENELEC and ETSI

Representation within European and International entities





Defining a national implementation plan for standards-related education

Organization

Related to the framework proposed by the "Masterplan on Education about Standardization"

<u>Aim</u>

> To build standards-related education, for all, from the youngest age until higher university education

Priorities

- > To develop standards-related education in secondary schools
- To integrate courses dedicated to the subject in existing university courses





Producing a basic tool: a continuous standards-training catalogue

Organization

- Divided into awareness sessions and trainings dedicated to standardization
- In line with the (inter-) sectoral standardization approach

The development of standards-related education will apply to:

<u>Form</u>

- Standard-setting bodies
- Regulations and guides
- > Economic advantages of standardization
- *▶ etc.*

Content

- > ICT
- Energy
- Biomedical technologies
- > etc.





Implementing a national flagship Master project in standardization

<u>Aim</u>

To create a higher education Master program focused on "Entrepreneurship and Standardization", specializing in ICT

Priorities

- To train students and employees on standardization
- > To encourage them to invest in the standardization activities within technical committees
- To encourage the development of research projects (particularly as part of the EU framework "Horizon 2020")
- To ensure a certain level of competitiveness and innovation for national enterprises





Representation within European and International entities

<u>Involvement of ANEC Standardization within various educational structures dedicated to standardization at European and international levels, such as:</u>

- Joint Working Group Education about Standardization of CEN, CENELEC, ETSI (JWG-EaS).
- European Academy for Standardization (EURAS)
- Working Group on Education of the International Federation of Standards Users (IFAN)

in order to facilitate the implementation, at national level, of good practices developed in this respect





Policy on Education about standardization 2013-2020 Conclusion

The national policy published in May 2013 should enable:

- To establish a societal standardization "anchorage" in Luxembourg
- To develop a national flagship Master project in the domain of standardization
- > To provide awareness sessions and trainings on standardization according to the market needs
- To develop research activities related to education about standardization
